

## ***“Inside Out”*** ***Isaiah 12***

Isaiah concludes this section of the book with a hymn written to Ahaz to repeat and turn to God.

### **God’s Inside Work V. 1-3**

“You” – this is the singular form in Hebrew. Written to and about one person or their individual relationship with God. This was a rare concept in the Hebrew Sacrificial system.

“Anger turned away” – God’s just judgment ended out of His great love. *Psalm 78:32-43*

“Comfort” – His anger and judgment will be replaced with comfort. *2 Corinthians 1:3-7*

“Salvation” – God alone can save. There is no hope within our own abilities.

### ***Exodus 15:1-18***

“Trust and Fear” – Trust and Fear God alone. *Proverbs 3:5-8*

“Strength and Song” – God’s strength leads to our song. (*Exodus 15:2*)

“Joy” – God’s well and joy not of man. *John 4: 13-14, 1 John 1:1-4*

### **The Outside Response V. 4-6**

“You” – this is the plural form in Hebrew. The idea is that “salvation is contagious and infects others. As we respond in Godly ways others join in and praise.

“Thanks” – Giving credit to where it belongs. *Psalm 105:1-6*

“Make known” – Dwell on His greatness and testify to what He has done. *Psalm 145:4-7*

“Proclaim” – “Go and tell” not a “come and see”. *Matthew 28:18-20*

“Praise” – Acknowledging God for who He is. *Psalm 98*

“Shout and Sing for Joy” – An overwhelming feeling of joy that cannot be contained.

### ***Psalm 66:1-4***

“Your” – this is the singular form in Hebrew. Isaiah returns to the King’s repentance and choices.

“Holy One of Israel” – King of Kings, righteous, faithful, lofty, incomparable, all loving  
*Isaiah 6:1-5*
