

## **“The Call”**

### ***Isaiah 6***

#### **The Vision V. 1-4**

Majesty – The throne room of God, His royal Robe and fiery royal attendants (“Seraph” – burning one) ***Psalm 72:18-19***

Transcendence – “High and Lifted up”, God is beyond our understanding, He transcends our knowledge, wisdom, comprehension and even words. ***Psalm 139:1-18***

Holy – Deity in essence and character, God worthiness. ***Revelation 5***

#### **The Confession V. 5**

Unclean lips – From the lips the heart is revealed. Isaiah his horrific position as he stood in the presence of a Holy God. He knew he would surely die. ***James 3:6-12***

#### **The Cleansing V. 6-7**

God then did the unexpected, He displayed Love and Grace by cleansing Isaiah and declaring him clean. This is a foreshadowing of redemption in Christ. The coal cleansed with fire and blood as it came from the sacrificial alter.

***Psalm 51***

#### **The Answer V. 8**

Isaiah now being clean responded to God’s question with great enthusiasm. “Here am I, send me!!!!” ***Exodus 4:10-17***

#### **The Message V. 9-13**

Verses 9 & 10 are the most quoted verses in the New Testament.

No ear tickling – Isaiah’s message was to be the brutal honest truth not ear tickling like the false Prophets. ***2 Timothy 4:1-5***

Hard hearts – Isaiah was to not try to soften their hearts but to tell of the consequences for their hearts were already hard and their ears closed. Only through the consequences will they once again listen to God. ***Mark 4:1-9***

A sprout from a stump – This could be a reference to the messiah, but most likely refers to the Godly remnant that will remain. ***Romans 11:1-6***
